## **Shrinking the Footprint SWITCHING TO A GREEN ENERGY SUPPLIER**

One of the simplest steps you can take in contributing to the effort against climate change is to switch to a green energy supplier.

The Diocese's preferred supplier of green electricity is Good Energy. There is an increasing number of energy supply companies offering green tariffs. However, Good Energy is at present the only UK supplier which provides 100% renewable electricity.

Good Energy's electricity is sourced from the natural energy of wind, sun or running water. How it works is that for every unit of electricity used by a Good Energy customer the company promises to buy an equivalent unit of electricity from a renewable source and supply this to the national grid.
