

**St Francis of Assisi Church

St. Francis of Assisi Church is situated west of Gillette Corner on the Great West Road.



From the A4 London, continue across the traffic lights at Gillette Corner and St. Francis Church can be seen 300 metres on your left. There is some off street parking in the white bays along the front of the church. Alternatively, turn left at the traffic lights at Gillette Corner into Syon Lane, 1st right into Northumberland Avenue. It is possible to park in Northumberland Avenue and then to walk up the alleyway to the Great West Road

From the West, there is no access to the Church. Turn right at the traffic lights at the Osterley Hotel into Wood Lane, 1st left into Northumberland Avenue. It is possible to park in Northumberland Avenue and then to walk up the alleyway to the Great West Road



The nearest tube station is Osterley on the Piccadilly Line. From here a number 91 bus will take you along the Great West Road to the Church.



Syon Lane Mainline Station is a short walk away. The station exit is in Syon Lane, head towards Gillette Corner, turn left at the garage and St. Francis Church can be seen on your left.

Tim Lomax is a worship leader, song writer and author with a heart for worship that resources mission-shaped church, including Liquid Worship, and has co-authored the Grove Booklet, *Liquid Worship* with Michael Moynagh. Tim is director of the 'fit for heaven?' worship conferences, a member of the song writers consultation and a member of GROW (Group for the Renewal of Worship). He lives in Cambridge with his wife Kate who is a Chaplain at Addenbrookes hospital.
