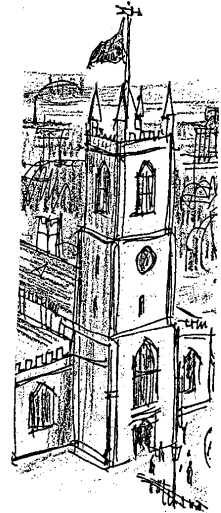

The Thames Chamber Choir has been based in London Docklands for six years. The choir enjoys performing a repertoire of music from the sixteenth and twentieth centuries, and often performs in aid of charities. The choir has given concerts at St. Anne's, Limehouse; All Saints, Poplar; The Space Arts Centre, Isle of Dogs; St James Garlickhythe in the City; and churches in Sussex, the Midlands and North Wales.
