ELEVATION FROM TERROR (commemorating 7/7)

Elevation from terror is a collaborative artwork to commemorate the London bombings. It will be displayed in St Pancras Church and St Paul's Cathedral, and will be coordinated by artists Ingrid Plum and Bob Aldous. The work involves the public, in making origami cranes that will fly over a map of London. This map is transformed during the exhibition by covering the aerial view of London with Silver Safety blankets, a reflective surface that alludes to a lake.

We will be running workshops to make origami birds. The birds will be based on the traditional origami crane that symbolizes peace. On the wings of the birds we can write messages for the victims and survivors of the bombings and they will then be set in flight across the interior of the church, circling eventually over an aerial map of London.

The inspiration for the work comes from mystical poem by Farid Attar-Conference of the birds. The birds gathered together to go on a migration to find the mythological king of the birds- the Simorgh. At the end of the pilgrimage only 30 birds survived. They looked for the mythological king of the birds but all they found was a vast lake that acted as a mirror. In it the birds

saw reflections of themselves and reflections of each other.

Ingrid and Robert will be running workshops to make the Origami Peace Cranes at St Ethelburga's Centre for Reconciliation and Peace, the Friends Meeting House in St Martins Lane and at St Pancras Church.
