Independent Asylum Commission – National Hearing

On 29 November in Lambeth Town Hall, Brixton Hill, London SW2 1RW. The Archbishop of Canterbury Dr Rowan Williams this week gave his firm support to the work of the Independent Asylum Commission highlighting the need to treat those fleeing oppression with dignity. The Commission is mandated to undertake its enquiry by the Citizen Organising Foundation, a coalition of faith and civil society groups and is conducting a national citizens' enquiry into the UK asylum system. It is travelling across the UK to hear the experiences of those who have gone through the asylum system, and the opinions of the public at large. 2.30pm – 5.30pm, The National Hearing with invited witnesses – all welcome as observers; 6.45pm, Public Roadshow with keynote speakers, resources and opportunity to contribute your experiences of the asylum system.
