The workshop will be led by Jeremy Fennell, who is the Regional Networking Support Officer at *bassac* with a specific brief to promote the development of practice that makes every action count – particularly working with the voluntary and community sector in England.

The workshop will be participative, and will use a combination of individual reflection, working in small groups, and group discussion.

Content

- how to develop an action plan for your group as a specific response to climate change
- how to use a planning tool to help develop practice in your local setting
- about some of the key materials and support available for community groups
- about other training and learning opportunities to help you to develop activity in your own community.
