The Passion: BBC series for Holy Week

The series will be scheduled in peak time on BBC1, with the first episode on Palm Sunday 16 March. It is likely to attract audiences in excess of 10 million. It tells the story of the last week of Jesus' life, his trial and crucifixion. The last episode, to be broadcast on Easter Sunday 23 March, dramatises his post-resurrection appearances. It has been made by award-winning drama producer Nigel Stafford-Clark. The part of Jesus is played by the relatively unknown Joseph Mawle, who at 33 is the same age as Jesus during the events of the Passion.
