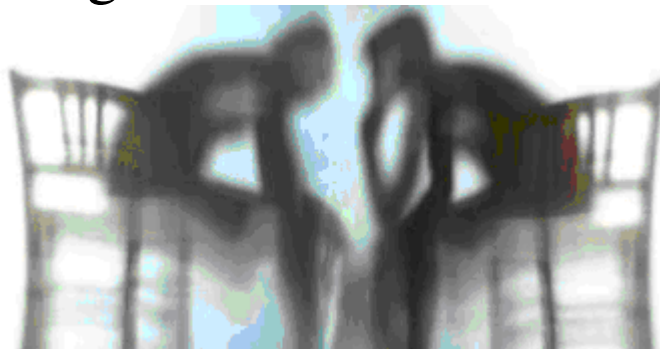


21st Century Priesthood TWO
