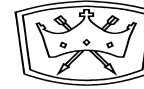

## The Hall Roof

St. Edmund's had just completed a project to put in ramps for wheel-chair access and lavatories for the disabled, when it was discovered that the hall roof will need attention within 5 years. So we must begin fund-raising again. We hope that Mark's Organ Marathon will make a major contribution to this.

We are researching the possibility of putting Photo-voltaic panels on the new roof. This should benefit the church in terms of usage of electricity, and any possible excess could be fed into the National Grid. In this way the church will be contributing to energy saving.

Please do so as soon as possible, either by email or telephone (**see box on opposite page**) or in person. Requests and dedications received by Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> July will be included in a souvenir brochure. The brochure itself, which will include full programme notes for the evening recital, will be available to purchase during the Marathon itself and a complimentary copy will be included with Recital tickets. I cannot guarantee to fulfil your request, especially if it is somewhat obscure, but I will do my best! Also please note that you cannot request works which I am already performing twice (such as Widor's Toccata and Bach's Toccata and Fugue in D Minor).

During the Marathon, you can send me messages of encouragement and last-minute requests by email or text (details opposite). I shall also have a live webcam on my website which will update every couple of minutes.
